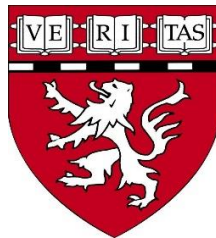

**8:00am-8:35 am: Professor Samuel Ting, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Physics Department:** “Unlocking the Mysteries of the Cosmos”

Professor Ting received the Nobel Prize for the discovery of the  $J$  particle at Brookhaven National Laboratory, as well as numerous other prizes during his career. His further seminal results include: observation of nuclear anti-matter (the anti-deuteron); measurement of the size of the electron family (the electron, the muon, and the tau) showing that the electron family has zero size (with a radius smaller than  $10^{-17}$  cm); precision study of light rays and massive light rays showing that light rays and massive light rays can transform into each other at high energies and providing a critical verification of the quark model; precision measurement of the radius of the atomic nuclei; discovery of the gluon (the particle responsible for transmitting the nuclear force); a systematic study of the properties of gluons; a precision measurement of muon charge asymmetry, demonstrating for the first time the validity of the Standard Electroweak Model (Weinberg, Glashow and Salam); and determination of the number of electron families and neutrino species in the Universe and the precision verification of the Electroweak Unification Theory. He developed the first large superconducting

magnet in space and has demonstrated separation of helium isotopes in space. Currently, he is leading a 15 nation, 500 physicist international collaboration to use the U.S. International Space Station (ISS) National Laboratory to probe fundamental questions of modern physics including the antimatter universe and the origin of cosmic rays and dark matter.

**8:35am-9:10am: Michael Kirk**, Filmmaker and Partial Creator of PBS Frontline, Former Nieman Fellow in Journalism at Harvard University

Michael John Kirk (born November 6th, 1947) is an award-winning documentary filmmaker and has produced more than 200 national television programs. A former Nieman Fellow in Journalism at Harvard University, Kirk was the senior producer of Frontline from the series' inception in 1983 until the fall of 1987, when he created his own production company, Kirk Documentary Group, based in Boston, Massachusetts. Kirk has won every major award in broadcast journalism, including four Peabody Awards, three duPont-Columbia Awards, fifteen Emmy Awards, two George Polk Awards, and eleven Writers Guild of America Awards.

**9:10am-9:45am: Dr. Steven Croopnick**, *Draper Laboratory*: "Apollo 11: Navigating to the moon and back."

Dr. Steven Croopnick received his S.B., S.M., and PhD from MIT in the Aeronautics and Astronautics Department with a focus on Astronautical Guidance. While at MIT, he was awarded the Luis de Florez prize for Ingenuity and Creativity for his work on a laser interferometer, a highly-accurate measuring device deriving its performance from the stability of a laser and the sub-wavelength optical interference patterns of an interferometer. Dr. Croopnick joined the MIT Instrumentation Laboratory (renamed Draper Laboratory) and subsequently served in positions ranging from student to Director of the Dynamics and Control Division.

Dr. Croopnick has made integral contributions to the designs and analyses for space-related programs important to the national interest, including the Apollo program, the Space Shuttle, and the Trident program. He led the team responsible for the development of the on-orbit autopilot for the Space Shuttle, and later was engaged in the laboratory's submarine-launched ballistic missile reliability effort.

During the Apollo program and under the direction of Hal Seward, Croopnick measured the variation of the horizon's blue-white boundary due to the aspect of the sun, cloud cover, and earth surfaces for Apollo's on-board navigation system. Measurement of the horizon and tracking of unknown landmark were options intended to simplify the operation of tracking specified landmarks. Under the supervision of Dick Battin, Croopnick evaluated the efficacy of using gravitational models of the moon which incorporated mass concentrations as an adjunct to the classical gravitational potential models, the effect of non-diagonal, correlated recursive filter initialization on navigation accuracy, and navigation based on the state at a defined epoch.

Dr. Croopnick is one of the few whose career at Draper has spanned over 50 years. He is one of the remaining original "Apollonauts" at Draper and remains actively involved in our nation's ballistic missile guidance systems and other projects at the lab.

**9:45am-10:20am: Dr. Stephen Zappala, Urologist:** "Observation and the Urologist's Perspective of Michelangelo's Frescoed Ceiling of the Sistine Chapel".

Stephen M. Zappala MD FACS is a Urologist in Andover, Massachusetts: a Massachusetts General Hospital Urology - Affiliated practice. He attended Boston College, University of Massachusetts Medical, with Urology training at UCLA and UMASS. His Pediatric Urology fellowship was at the Hospital for Sick Children, Great Ormond Street, London, England. Dr. Zappala has obtained 14 U.S. patents on medical devices and had a pivotal role in the development and commercialization of the 4Kscore Test, a risk stratification biomarker panel for aggressive CaP. He is a member of the Medical Advisory Boards of OPKO Health, Miami, FL and Cellanyx, Boston, MA, combining a microfluidics platform with artificial intelligence and live-cell cultures to predict tumor behavior. He serves on the Clinical Advisory Board of Riverside Partners, a Boston-based, private equity firm specializing in healthcare and technology. Dr. Zappala's interests include European history, Renaissance art, and the artistic creations of Michelangelo. His presentation is entitled "Pigments, Postures, and Plaster - a Urologist's Observations of the Sistine Chapel Ceiling". Dr. Zappala shares his unique and inspiring interpretations on the cryptic messages on the ceiling frescoes, focusing on the "Creation of Adam".

**10:20am-10:55am: Professor Charles Fried, Beneficial Professor of Law, Harvard Law School, Former United States Solicitor General under President Ronald Reagan, “To Whom Are We Responsible”**

Educated at Princeton, Oxford and Columbia Law School, Charles Fried, the Beneficial Professor of Law, has been teaching at Harvard Law School since 1961. He was Solicitor General of the United States, 1985-89, and an Associate Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court of Massachusetts, 1995-99. His scholarly and teaching interests have been moved by the connection between normative theory and the concrete institutions of public and private law. During his career at Harvard he has taught Criminal Law, Commercial Law, Roman Law, Torts, Contracts, Labor Law, Constitutional Law and Federal Courts, Appellate and Supreme Court Advocacy. The author of many books and articles, his *Anatomy of Values* (1970), *Right and Wrong* (1978), and *Modern Liberty* (2006) develop themes in moral and political philosophy with applications to law. *Contract as Promise* (1980), *Making Tort Law* (2003, with David Rosenberg) and *Saying What the Law Is: The Constitution in the Supreme Court* (2004) are fundamental inquiries into broad legal institutions. *Order & Law: Arguing the Reagan Revolution* (1991) discusses major themes developed in Fried's time as Solicitor General, and finally his 1974 *Medical Experimentation: Personal Integrity and Social Policy* now in a new 2016 edition, explores some of the themes he will touch upon today. In recent years Fried has taught Constitutional Law and Contracts. During his time as a teacher he has also argued a number of major cases in state and federal courts, most notably *Daubert v. Merrell Dow Pharmaceuticals*, in which the Supreme Court established the standards for the use of expert and scientific evidence in federal courts
